

DIRECTIONS FOR ENTERING FIRST BAPTIST CHURCH OF JONESBORO AREA

On Friday, October 28, there is a Children's Festival occurring on the First Baptist Church campus in addition to our State Honor Chorus event. The FBCJ staff assures me there will be enough parking area for us and that it will be safe. However, carpooling is strongly encouraged as parking is scattered around the facilities.

In order to enter the area away from the Festival, the staff recommends that you exit off I-75 at the Morrow/Hwy 54/Clayton State University exit 233 and go right onto Hwy 54. You will pass by Southlake Mall and continue to Jonesboro. After you pass the Train Depot, you will take a right onto Church St. and proceed toward the Worship Center where you will see St. James Place Welcome Center. If you are coming in a bus or van, you can drop the students, teachers, and parents here which is where registration will be held. To park, proceed down Church St. to Sims St. where you take a right then shortly take another right on W. Mill St. There will be parking on the right and bus parking on the left just past the Singles Center.

A map of the area is to be posted on the website to assist you in navigating this new venue. Downloading a copy of it to bring with you will be of great value in getting around FBCJ. We begin in St. James Place for registration, proceed to the Worship Center which is attached to St. James Place to hear the acapella men's group, Somethin' Else, perform, and then proceed to the ROC which is across the street on Church St. from the Worship Center.

To dine out for supper, go to Cloud St and then take a right on College St. which brings you to Fayetteville Rd. Take a right and proceed to a traffic light at Smith St. Turn left on Smith St. which quickly brings you to Tara Blvd. On the corner is a Burger King. Take a right and you will see an Arby's and across the street is a Golden Corral. Further north on Tara Blvd. is a Chick-Fil-A on the right. These restaurants serve quickly and reasonably priced.
